FIGHT-REC is an online database to allow Fighters, Coaches & Promoters to find available opponents and increase their standings by taking opportunities which may come.

All data is published below under the Fight-Rec page, where likeminded Coaches & Promoters will search for suitable opponents for both Title and None Title Bouts.

The Database is intended for the use as a Matchmaking Tool for promoters to identify Fighters & Coaches for safe and credible bout planning for reputable and fair bouts to be agreed.

Mis-use of any information including e-mail addresses for commercial purposes will result in legal action under the Data Protection Act 1988.

The data is in weight groups format ages in ascending order and ranks the highest ratios higher in age order. But a fighter with 1 fight 1 win and 100% ratio does not mean they are better than someone with 10 fights and 8 wins on a 80% ratio. As can see that is a massive experience deficit between them.

But as can now see how fights they have had and Win/Loss ratios gives great insight into fair and safe match making for Gala Events.

Is your data missing:

We must stress the data is 99% accurate.

Any fighters that didn't put the correct DOB or missed it all together, will have in accuracies.

Prior to 2020 fighters could register through Kihapp and only had to give age, not DOB. It was 2020 onwards when had to enter DOB or could not register.

Data prior to this does have missing fighters due to lack of DOB and data consistency, hence why we keep asking for people to ensure their data inputted is correct.

The Data anchor we use in Fight-Rec and Grand Prix Rankings is the same Name & DOB. Once these are entered correctly and consecutively the data can compile and calculate. Any inconsistencies will split or delete the data, any data errors caused from inconsistent input of Name or DOB cannot be changed unfortunately.
